From the M1 turn west onto the M25 – towards Heathrow

Once on the M25 leave at Junction 20. (Kings Langley) taking the minor exit off the roundabout signposted to Kings Langley. (don't take the larger exit - the dual carriageway A41 to Berkhamstead and Aylesbury)

After about half a mile there is a roundabout, turn right, into Link Road.

Continue another half-mile, over the canal, up to a T-Junction and turn right again.

You will pass Kings Langley station on your left, then underneath the M25, and under a railway bridge which is single track, controlled by traffic lights. You are now on a road called Gallows Hill.

Take the second left turn into Gallows Hill Lane. If you pass the Unicorn pub you have gone too far

After about a mile, the Community Centre is set back from this road on the left directly opposite the Royal Oak Pub. (you'll see a poster for the concert attached to a lamppost at the turning!)

If there are no more parking spaces outside the community centre, then drive another 50 yards towards the village (continuing up the hill) and take the left turn immediately before the first parade of shops (signposted with a blue P) There is a large car park behind these shops, and only a short walk back to the Community Centre.

The Royal Oak Pub opposite (WD5 0ET Tel 01923 265163) does a good roast dinner on Sundays - but you need to book in advance!
