## Abbots Langley Community Centre.

(opposite the Royal Oak Public House) Gallows Hill Lane Abbots Langley WD5 0AP

From the M1 southbound turn west onto the M25 – towards Heathrow (anticlockwise)

Once **on the M25 travelling anti-clockwise** leave at Junction 20. (Kings Langley) taking the **fourth exit** off the roundabout signposted to Kings Langley.

(don't take the larger third exit - which is the dual carriageway A41 to Berkhamsted and Aylesbury)

If you are approaching on the **M25 travelling** *clockwise* at Junction 20 then take the **second exit** off the roundabout signposted to Kings Langley.

(don't take the larger first exit - which is the dual carriageway A41 to Berkhamsted and Aylesbury)

\*\*\*\*

After about half a mile there is a roundabout, turn right into **Home Park Mill Link Road**. Continue another half-mile, over the canal, up to a T-Junction and turn right again. into **Station Road** (no road sign here!)

You will pass Kings Langley station on your left, then pass underneath the M25, and then under a railway bridge which is single track, controlled by traffic lights. You are now on a road called **Gallows Hill.** 

Take the second left turn into Gallows Hill Lane.

## If you pass the Unicorn pub you have missed the turn!

After about a mile up the hill the Community Centre is set back from this road on the left just past the Royal Oak Pub (which is on the right.)



If there are no more parking spaces outside the community centre, then drive another 50 yards towards the village (continuing up the hill) and take the left turn immediately before the first parade of shops (signposted with a blue P) There is a large car park behind these shops, and only a short walk back to the Community Centre.

**From the Abbots Langley Village centre** (if you have arrived from the church end of the village, or missed the Community Centre on the way in) head away from the high street (passing the Post Office on your right)



Ideally you should pass the row of shops shown here on the right - and turn right to go and park in the car park which is behind them. (There is limited parking at the community centre)



The Community centre is a two minute walk (or very short drive) continuing away from the village centre.

Pass Vine House Medical Centre on the left



- the Community Centre car park is the next entrance on the right
